EXUMA CAYS ITINERARY

Pristine cays in the Exumas offer guests exciting animal encounters, dramatic walls, and coral reefs alive with thousands of ocean-dwellers. Exuma Cays charters depart from Nassau.

TIGER BEACH ITINERARY

Visit the remote areas around the West End of Grand Bahama where tiger, lemon and Caribbean reef sharks provide spectacular photo opportunities. Departing from Old Bahama Bay, the Bahamas Aggressor travels 25 miles (40 kilometers) to Little Bahama Bank.



A SHARK SAFARI BAHAMAS

Pelagics get the spotlight in the Bahamas, but the western Atlantic's reefs and wrecks are swarming with spectacular macro life: octopuses, arrow crabs, Pederson shrimp, leopard flat worms, and red-tipped sea goddesses.

- Dark grey or grey-brown coloration
- Short, rounded snout, large eyes

GREAT HAMMERHEAD SHARKS

- Length: up to 20 feet, or 6 meters
- Flat head, sickle-shaped large dorsal fin
- Weight: up to 1,000 pounds, or 450 kg

**GREY REEF SHARKS, BULL SHARKS, SILKY SHARKS,

TIGER SHARKS

- Length: 16 feet, or 5 meters
- Blue to light-green coloration with dark spots and stripes that fade with age
- Wedge-shaped head, high back

LEMON SHARKS

- Length: 8-10 feet, or 2.5-3 meters
- Pale, yellow-brown coloration
- Two dorsal fins of similar size

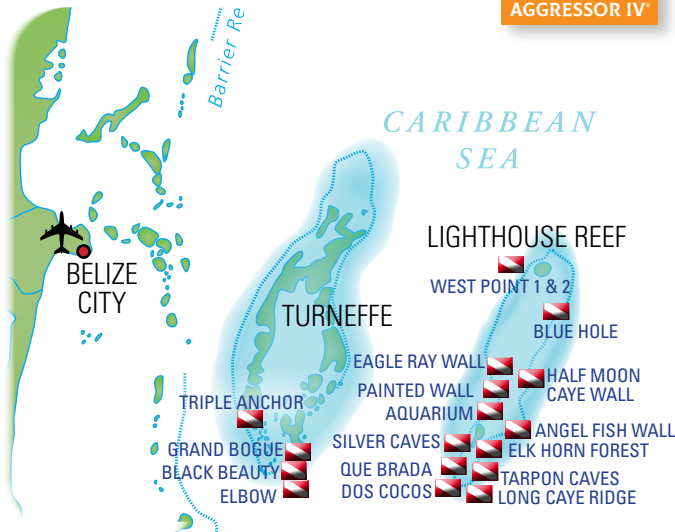

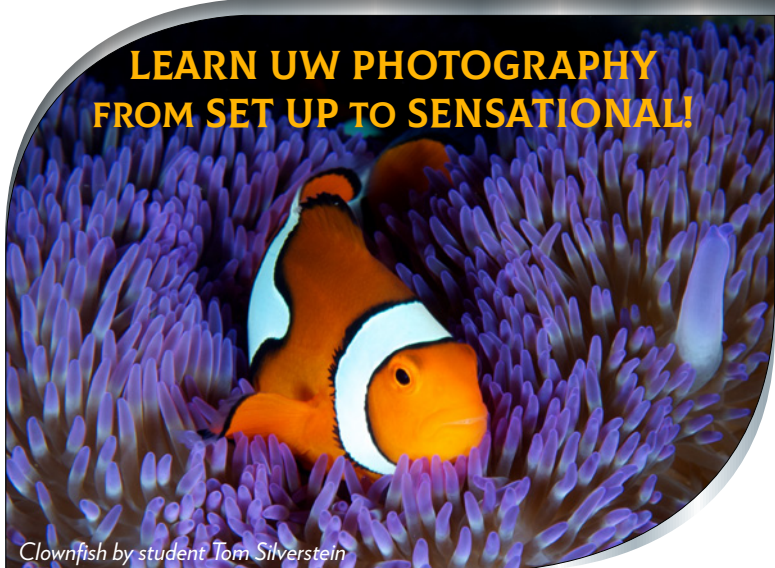

COCOS ISLAND, COSTA RICA:

Two Yachts, Ten Nights

The Okeanos Aggressor I® and Okeanos Aggressor II® dock in Puntarenas, Costa Rica with the journey to Cocos Island taking approximately 36 hours. Rocky pinnacles surrounding Cocos are beacons for big animals and big action. Ten-night charters offer up to 24 dives. (No night diving is currently offered at Cocos.) Weather permitting, guests visit the Island's ranger station and take a plunge in the pools of Cocos' many waterfalls. When the yachts return to the mainland, transportation is provided back to the host hotels or San Jose (SJO) airport.

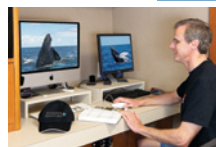

DOMINICAN REPUBLIC:

January - April, Seven Nights, Snorkeling Only

Guests board Saturday afternoon with an evening departure for the Silver Bank Sanctuary. Monday through Thursday afternoon, whales are observed from the mothership and from two 17-foot (five-meter) boats that are fitted with a ladder for easy water entry/exit and a full-length bimini top for sun protection. The excursions last one and a half to three hours depending on the proximity of the whales and time of day. If conditions permit, guests may enter the ocean for a “soft-in-water” encounter, which is a low-impact, non-aggressive activity permitted by the Sanctuary regulations.

The Turks & Caicos Aggressor II® returns from the whale watching sanctuary to Puerto Plata on Friday. The staff hosts a sunset cocktail party Friday evening. Check-out is Saturday morning.

Multilingual guides from the Galapagos Marine Reserve & Galapagos National Park are onboard and join guests on hikes, snorkeling excursions, and scuba dives.

The Galápagos Aggressor III is the premier liveaboard in the archipelago with an operating Park Permit since 1993.

The Galapagos Aggressor III departs from Baltra and is the perfect platform for a Galapagos diving holiday. The Galapagos Islands are a UNESCO* World Heritage Site.

The Galapagos Aggressor III offers a new itinerary in compliance with the Galapagos National Park regulations, which requires companies with permits to follow the exact itinerary. A maximum of four dives will be offered daily; however, land tours or snorkeling excursions may be offered in the place of a dive. On the first day, there are

two dives and on Wednesday, one dive and a land visit. One night dive (Wolf Island) and two land excursions per week are offered.

The new diving areas added to the itinerary are Bartolome Punta, Cousins Rock, and Cabo Douglas. Itineraries may vary due to weather conditions and park regulations. An overnight hotel stay in Guayaquil, Ecuador is recommended due to airline schedules.

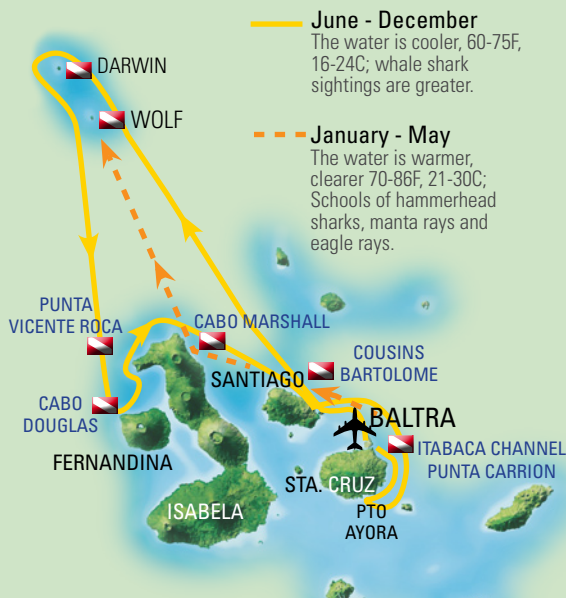

The four- and five-night itineraries provides an up-close and personal adventure for shark seekers who enter surface or submersible cages to experience great whites. Guests rotate entering the cages every hour while seeing several sharks during each dive. All dives in the shark cages use surface supplied air sources or hookahs. 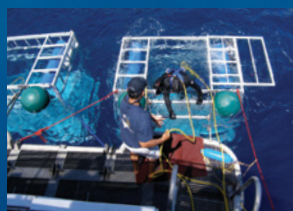

“We arrived to the Island early morning and deployed the cages immediately.

At 9:00 a.m. divers were in the water, ready to encounter face-to-face with the mighty great white shark. It only took ten minutes for the first shark to come and greet our divers.

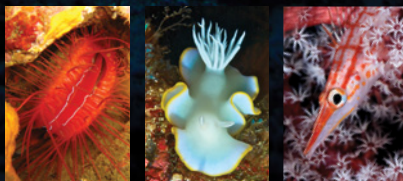


Rock, Disco, Swing, all genres in Palau

“Cruising through the mushroom-shaped Rock Islands, only a short distance from Blue Corner, is Blue Holes. Four holes break the reef, leading down into one large chamber. Ambient light from above fills the cavern creating the perfect setting for stunning wide angle photos. Turtles, barracuda and whitetip sharks appear from the darkness.

Divers’ flashlights reveal the electric scallop or “disco clam.” Shining lights reveal the mollusk’s white filament, which appears as an electric pulse, just like a disco strobe light. Other hidden treasures include nudibranchs, seahorses, and remarkable macro life.”

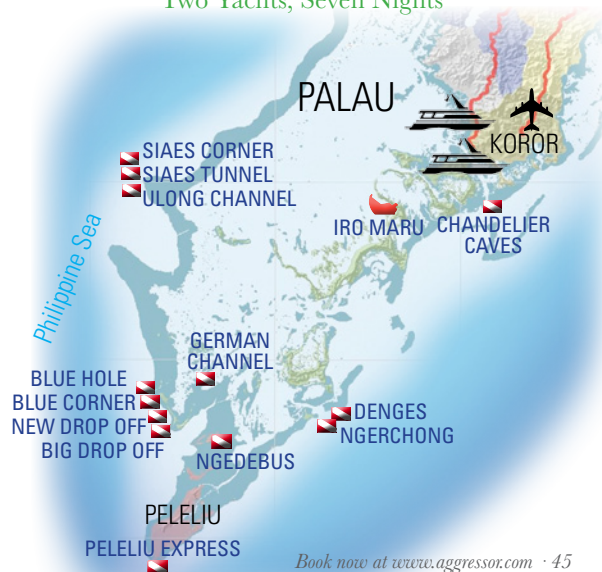


Both yachts have 18-passenger, custom skiff dives for land excursions to Milky Way beach "mud spa" and Jellyfish Lake. Palau's freshwater lake is swarming with thousands of stingless jellies.

Palau is 900 miles (1,448 kilometers) southwest of Guam and 400 miles (644 kilometers) south of Yap, at the westernmost edge of Micronesia. Guests arriving Sunday evening are greeted and transferred to the yacht. If you are already on island, you may board Sunday afternoon. Monday through Friday there are four dives offered each day and a night dive on three evenings. Saturday is a half-day of diving. An optional tour of Peleliu's WWII battlefields is offered mid-week. The 130-foot (39-meter), 22-passenger Red Sea Aggressor III® yacht operates from the Port Ghalib, Egypt yacht marina and resort area.
